



## HOW WE ARE HELPING TO KEEP YOU SAFE



### **We may restrict visitor access to protect our patients and staff.**

We are adjusting visitor access and movement within the facility.

### **We are providing extra training for staff, and education for patients about the importance of hand hygiene, respiratory hygiene, and cough etiquette.**



Tissues, alcohol-based hand sanitizer, and trash cans will be provided in the service area. Soap and water will continue to be available at all handwashing sinks.

### **We are monitoring healthcare personnel for symptoms of respiratory infection.**



We are instructing staff who have fever, cough, or shortness of breath to stay home and not come to work.

### **We will be checking the temperature of patients and visitors for everyone's protection.**

If we discover you have a fever, we can work with you to reschedule your appointment.



### **We are prepared for proper use of personal protective equipment for COVID-19.**

You may see a change in the personal protective equipment (i.e., gowns, masks, gloves) that staff wear or that you are asked to wear to protect other patients.



### **We are continuing our routine cleaning and disinfection procedures as they are also the procedures recommended for protecting patients from COVID-19.**

Any surface, supplies, or equipment located within the patient station will continue to be disinfected or discarded. We will ensure any surface, supplies, or equipment located within six feet of an ill patient is disinfected or discarded.
